THE PRESIDENT HAS APPROVED THE FOLLOWING:

August 31, 1965

H. J. Res. 95, Joint Resolution to designate the lake to be formed by the waters impounded by Sanford Dam, Canadian River project, Texas, as "Lake Meredith".

H. R. 881, An Act to authorize the establishment of the Alibates Flint Quarries and Texas Panhandle Pueblo Culture National Monument.

H. R. 1291, An Act for the relief of the children of Mrs. Elizabeth A. Dombrowski.

H. R. 7181, An Act to provide for the commemoration of certain historical events in the State of Kansas, and for other purposes.

H. R. 7596, An Act to amend title 10, United States Code, to remove inequities in the active duty promotion opportunity of certain Air Force officers.

H. R. 7765, An Act making appropriations for the Departments of Labor, and Health, Education, and Welfare, and related agencies, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966, and for other purposes.
