This key is the official key used when the President, for example, is to blow the first dynamite explosion on a dam -- he pushes the telegraph key, and it is set up simultaneously to wherever the dam might be. The key had pics taken of it - in color - and then was sent to Jiggs Fauver for safe - keeping and custody of it. He will be responsible for getting it to the "right place at the right time."
