THE PRESIDENT HAS TODAY APPROVED THE FOLLOWING:

- S. 597, An Act to amend the Public Health Service Act to provide for a program of grants to assist in meeting the need for adequate medical library services and facilities.
- H. R. 3141, An Act to amend the Public Health Service Act to improve the educational quality of schools of medicine, dentistry, and osteopathy, to authorize grants under that Act to such schools for the awarding of scholarships to needy students, and to extend expiring provisions of that Act for student loans and for aid in construction of teaching facilities for students in such schools and schools for other health professions, and for other purposes.
- H. R. 7169, An Act to amend the Securities Act of 1933 with respect to certain registration fees.
- H. R. 7484, An Act to amend title 10, United States Code, to provide for the rank of lieutenant general or vice admiral of officers of the Army, Navy, and Air Force while serving as Surgeons General.
- H. R. 7743, An Act to establish a system of loan insurance and a supplementary system of direct loans, to assist students to attend post-secondary business, trade, technical, and other vocational schools.
- H. R. 9247, An Act to provide for participation of the United States in the HemisFair 1968 Exposition to be held at San Antonio, Texas, in 1968, and for other purposes.
- H. R. 10238, An Act to provide labor standards for certain persons employed by Federal contractors to furnish services to Federal agencies, and for other purposes.

THE PRESIDENT HAS APPROVED THE FOLLOWING:

October 22, 1965

- S. 32, An Act to authorize the Secretary of the Interior to construct, operate, and maintain the southern Nevada water project, Nevada, and for other purposes.
- H. R. 7919, An Act to provide for the establishment of the Roger Williams National Memorial in the city of Providence, Rhode Island, and for other purposes.
