					While there, the President toured the area where much activity was taking place -- workmen from the ranch were trying their hardest to clean the area per the President's request... The President climbed out of the jeep and started picking up logs that were once live trees and threw them aside so that the shredder wouldn't break down if it hit them. Mrs. Johnson and SS also helped the area become cleaner...

					During the afternoon, the President would get in his jeep, climb out again... stop and watch -- then back into the jeep -- and just generally supervising the clean-up campaign.
