Mr. Bardwell has been in ill health the last few months and commented this visit would do more for his health than anything, and he spoke with almost tears in his eyes of yesteryear when they first met and knew the President - to whom both referred and addressed as "Lyndon." The President autographed pictures - 1)"To my dear friend, Dan Quill, with affection, LBJ" and 2) "to my dear friend, Malcolm Bardwell, with affection, LBJ". He also autographed a picture <del>for</del> "To Jess McNeel, from his long-time friend, LBJ" (Mr. McNeel is a business partner of Mr. Bardwell.
