He made mention that he would prefer to address a small (300) businessmen group there in Austin - but in exploring the meetings, conferences and goings-on in Austin, there was really no group meeting that day he could talk to. The President was obviously anxious to make this address somewhere and was deliberate in doing so by his comments.
