On the humowous side, the President looked into Okie's eyes, and said, "I see where you have three telephones in your shop, do you need that many?" Okie said, "I have four people using the telephones." The President said, "Well, the President has to have two -- how many do you have to have?" Okie replied, "Two, sir."
