Each member of Congress responded to the President's invitation to comment and discuss the subjects that were under consideration. The pause in bombing in VietNam was one of the subjects discussed. (fr Press briefing \$2x All discussions were held confidential, and those attending agreed to keep results of the mtg in confidence. As each member departed, the President stood by the Cabinet Room door and shook hands and thanked each one for coming (except for Senators Russell and Long whom JV had secreted in MW's office on the President's instruction)
