		2:45p EST			Lunch was served which consisted of crab/lobster newberg on rice, green salad, roll, butter, beverage, ice cream (President had tapioca). The President discussed several matters with the Congressmen and Mr. Jacobsen, and it was decided by the President that he would sign the Medicare Extension Bill tomorrow in San Antonio at the Victoria Plaza Housing Development (a model housing development for the elderly), after which he plans to attend Good Friday services at the Cathedral in San Antonio.
