Eugene M. Locke, of Texas, to be Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the United States of America to Pakistan.

Jacob D. Beam, of New Jersey, a Foreign Servicer of the Class of Career Minister, to be Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the United States of America to the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic.

Glenn W. Sutton, of Georgia, to be a Member of the United States Tariff Commission for the term expiring June 16, 1972. (Reappointment)
