"The President reviewed with the leadership the 91 items on the legislative chart giving particular emphasis to the possibility of reporting and passing by 4 Jul, 28 measures. The leadership of both sides of the Capitol agreed that this was an objective which could be reached and promised to bend every effort in that direction. They also agreed to tell the press on leaving the meeting that the house would have enacted possibly 70 of the 91 bills by the 4th of July and the Senate would be close on its heels. The Pres. reported to the leadership the latest developments in the South and told of his hope that it would be possible to persuade the civil rights leaders to conclude their demonstration this weekend."
