					* Komer briefed the President on the latest developments in the area of civilian progress in VietNam. The primary point of Komer's briefing was leading to his request for three man team per area liberated in VietNam, telling the President that Westmoreland's troops go in and clean the VietCong out and then go off and leave the liberated area. Komer pointed out there was a need for a team -- a captain and two enlisted men-- to maintain the area once liberated. President seemed to be pleased with the report and to like the suggestion. He called Secy McNamara and told him of Komer's request and said he wanted <del>xxx</del> him to give Komer all the help he could. The President in transmitting the request to Secy McNamara added onto the request by telling McNamara he needed an agricultural man also, referring to him as a "county agent." When he hung up the phone, mjdr suggested that perhaps it would be good to make it a team--a county agent and a home demonstration agent. The
