Sargent Shriver and Mr. Bill Crook (head of the Poverty Corps in Texas)... and their aides --- Bill Mullins (for Shriver) and Paul Duncan (for Crook)... and returned to the office area at 5:36 pm (Note: The President was rather upset that Mr. Shriver and his party were arriving at the LBJ Ranch -- although he had earlier in the day invited Mr. Shriver -- he had asked that Mr. Shriver call him to let him know whether or not he was going to come to the ranch before heading back to Washington, and Mr. Shriver never did so... The first that the President heard of Mr. Shriver's arrival was when his airplane radioed the tower at the LBJ Ranch requesting permission to land)
