Frank C. Di Luzio, of New Mexico, to be an Assistant Secretary of the Interior. (New Position)

Paul A. Miller, of West Virginia, to be an Assistant Secretary of Health, Education, and Welfare.

Walter J. Cummings, Jr., of Illinois, to be United States Circuit Judge, Seventh Circuit, to fill a new position created by P. L. 89-372 approved March 18, 1966.

Thomas E. Fairchild, of Wisconsin, to be United States Circuit Judge, Seventh Circuit, vice F. Ryan Duffy, retired.

Donald P. Lay, of Nebraska, to be United States Circuit Judge, Eighth Circuit, vice Harvey M. Johnsen, retired.

Ted Cabot, of Florida, to be United States District Judge for the Southern District of Florida to fill a new position created by P. L. 89-372, approved March 18, 1966.

Wilfrid E. Johnson, of Washington, to be a Member of the Atomic Energy Commission for the remainder of the term expiring June 30, 1967, vice John Gorham Palfrey.
