These records were formerly held by the Soviet Union. These two Air Force pilots, as members of the YF-12A test force, established three absolute and six jet class world records in one day. Stephens set the new world speed record of more than 2,070 miles per hour and a new altitude record of over 80,259 feet Daniel set new speed records of more than 1,640 miles per hour and 1,680 miles per hour over the 500 and 1,000 kilometer closed circuit courses.
