6:45 am            The President awakened

7:10 am            The President had breakfast -- chipped beef on toast and tea. Judge Moursund breakfasted with the President

8 am                Mr. Jacobsen entered the President's bedroom and the President quickly dispensed with the night reading.

8:15 am            Mr. Watson joined the group and Mr. Jacobsen reported that the President was very cheerful -- talking, kidding, telling stories -- they did not talk "shop."

9:30 am            Mr. Watson and Mr. Jacobsen departed and Steve Martini arrived to trim the President's hair.

9:40 am            Mr. Valenti joined the President, who made a telephone call to Courtenay asking her "who do you love?"

10:05 am           Mr. Moyers and Mr. Valenti were still in the bedroom with the President. (I do not have a time when Mr. Moyers arrived)

11:20 am           Mrs. Johnson was standing by the table in the great hall when Luci emerged from her bedroom. Mrs. Johnson called to the President through the open door of his bedroom: "Daddy Boy, here comes your little girl." The President immediately came into the hall (I understand he had been out in the hall several times waiting for Luci but then went back to his bedroom to watch television). He took Luci's arm and then told her she needed a little color in her cheeks. She stopped and looked in her compact and pinched her cheeks. Father, Mother and daughter departed the second floor on the elevator together.

As Luci departed one of the White House maids who had been in service for about 25 years called to her: "Even though you'll be a Mrs. you will always be my little girl."

I do not have the Secret Service reports for the day of the wedding yet, but do have the following time:

12:15 am            The President and Luci started down the aisle

12:16 am            Reached the communion kneeling rail and handed Luci to Pat

12:41 am            Luci and Pat exchanged wedding vows and were pronounced man and wife.
