September 13, 1966

The President met with Dr. William A. Wexler of Savannah, Georgia, President of B'nai B'rith, and with Rabbi Jay Kaufman, Executive Vice President of B'nai B'rith, and Harry C. McPherson, Jr., on Saturday afternoon at 5:30. The discussion was about the concern of the American Jewish community over published reports that the President, in meeting with the Jewish War Veterans during the week before, had equated American Jewish support for the Administration's Vietnam policy with continued American support for the State of Israel. The President told Dr. Wexler and Rabbi Kaufman that he had only expressed his appreciation of the Jewish War Veterans' resolution of support for his Vietnam policy and had urged them to make this available to their membership. It was acknowledged that the credibility of the U. S. commitment to the territorial integrity of small States was involved in our Vietnam commitment, and that should this credibility be lost by a withdrawal from the struggle in Vietnam, our other commitments would be similarly discredited. The B'nai B'rith leaders expressed their profound appreciation of the President's support for Israel in the past, and they said that never in modern history have there been a more profound rapport between an American Administration, the Jewish community, and the State of Israel. They said that they intended to release a statement which would attempt to clarify what the President had said, and they did so on the following Monday. The story appeared on page 4 of the New York Times on Tuesday, September 13, 1966.
