" at 7:30a this morning, the President awakened, got his papers from outside his bedroom door, and then went into his bathroom to read them so as not to have to turn on the light in his room to awaken Mrs. Johnson. At 8:00a a situation room report went to the President and Paul Glynn took it to him. At this time the President ordered his breakfast. Paul turned lights on in the room, and Mrs. Johnson awakened and went to her own room to dress. Jake Jacobsen and Marvin Watson came in to talk to the President. Mrs. Johnson returned to say goodbye to the President before leaving for NYC. Jack Valenti came in at 10:30a. The President dressed in a blue suit, but wore his new brown shoes this morning--they are the new shoe from Lucchese and he wants to see if he likes them. About 10 minutes before coming to the office, he visited w/ Jim Bishop in the West Hall--for a cup of coffee. He seems edgy and nervous." Paul Glynn:m
