	8:15a				The President came up for BREAKFAST w/ Emmett Riordan, John Gonella, Simon McHugh, Lt. Tim Leonard, Jake Jacobsen (ordered scrambled eggs "like Simon has" with piece of bacon and one pancake.) The stewards brought a plate of pancakes only. "I want some scrambled eggs like Simon has." The stewards then brought two fried eggs with sausage. The President quipped, "This is why the polls are like they are--there's a problem of communication.!" (The President ate two pancakes, fried eggs, toast and jelly. ) The President read the Sunday papers and talked about Jewish problems--the problems he was having with the Jewish people concerning VietNam. He asked Simon McHugh when Vicky was coming up. "No idea," was Simon's reply. "Remember all the wedding vows?" said the President. Simon replied that he had reminded Vicky about honor and obey, but it was no good." The President asked John Gonella how he liked his job. When Tim told him that his Congressman was Jed Johnson, the President said, "He's a good, bright boy."
