He said later that he enjoyed the sermon very much and though the priest had in a very simple way--delivered a powerful argument for civil rights. At the collection, the President reached into his wallet and produced a \$20 bill for the basket. At the second collection near the end of Mass, the President did likewise. After church, the President stood outside the church and greeted many of the parishioners, especially Betty and Tom Weinheimer, Mr. and Mrs. Lawrence Klein (he told Mrs. Klein he was giving her one of the old station wagons from KTBC),

The President, Mrs. Johnson, Lynda, George Hamilton, and Mary Slater sat on the front row on the right side of the church with Mr. & Mrs. Rostow and J.C. Kellam sat on the row behind. The rector made some jokes about "our friend the cat" as a yellow alley cat ran through the church, then remarked that they should change the name of the church to St. Francis for the preceding Sunday they had a cat, a dog, and a bird in the church during services. After services the party went into the parish hall for coffee--the President visited with the people and with some of the PRESS.
