He replied that it was going very well, and the Amb agreed that some 1/2 million lives were preserved by use of the vaccine. The President began to generalize and asked what became of the Intertional Health Act and said the Dept of State had let down on pushing it to get it out of the Rules Committee. He asked the DOS people present if they could get Rusk to call McCormack and Smith (Rules Committee) to be sure it could be taken out of Committee (They did get in touch w/ Rusk, and Douglas MacArthur is preparing a memorandum to brief the President on developments) In talking to Garcia-Godoy, the President congratulated him the peaceful transition.
