He was disappointed that the deer had not been "drenched" (dipped in antiseptic solution to kill any infectious organisms) but Dale assured him that the salt cakes put out for the deer to lick. <i>contains an antiseptic solution.</i> The President instructed Pat on business mechanics of being at KTBC, told him he should meet as many of the people who do business with KTBC as possible, get to know them--their names--and their faces. He suggested that Luci and Pat invite their business friends to dinner, and advised that they should learn to like something about everybody.
