					Mrs. Johnson went ahead to the St. Barnabas Gift Shop, leaving the President to visit with the people gathered outside the City Hall. The President posed for pictures on the steps of the City Hall, and then called first Mary S, then Helen Thomas to be in the pictures with him.	
	10:46a				The President, Mary S. and Lem Johnson departed the City Hall by Lincoln, Lem Johns driving. The President talked informally with the reporters and photographers before departing from the car. Immediately before the car left, Helen Thomas ran up and asked the President to announce that he was going to be a grandfather, so that she could sleep well at night. The President laughed, and said, "Helen, I'll give you that scoop you have been wanting. Hal Pachios is going to the Philippines tomorrow!"	
	10:57a		t		On the drive back, the President talked about his various Press Conferences. He called Tom Johnson on the radio phone when he remembered that he had not recorded a statement on the investment tax bill that he had promised Jack Murphy. After checking, it was discovered that Mr. Murphy had received the necessary information and that it was not necessary for the President to return. n The President then gave Tom some background information to give to the press.	
	11:08a				The President adn Mary S to the office. As the President got out of the car, he told Clarence to find Pat and Luci and tell them that he would meet them up at the Hartman. The President then went into the office and was reading tickers.
