Mrs. Johnson asked the President's advise on what Liz Carpenter could tell the press of their plans and their gifts to one another. The President then asked for Mary S to check on his gifts to Mrs. Johnson and give him a written report.</p> <p>The P^Resident asked to have a list of the calls that Marvin Watson, Bill Moyers, and Jake Jacobsen had made during the day to Congressional members and a sentence summary of each.</p> <p>Lynda and Mary S rubbed the President's hands with oil while he talked with Clark Clifford and Mrs. Johnson and looked at television. --Note, the three original television evisions had been replaced with three larger color tvs.</p>
