Congressman Jake Pickle and Mr. Dick Brown (The President had asked for Mr. Brown when he first arrived this morning, but somehow lines got crossed and he was not brought in until now. George Christian had gone int the President's office at 3:58p while mf and mary s were helping the President work his desk and asked if the President would like to wait until tomorrow to see Brown. The President replied that early this morning he had asked to see Brown and Shanks. Shanks had appeared late--fifteen minutes after the President had originally scheduled a luncheon with Gov. Connally and Gov. Morrison. The President said that he guessed that now that he was planning to leave by 4:30p at the latest, he guessed that Pickle would show up with Brown at 4:30 or 4:45 and make him miss his deer for the day.)
