Gonzales was there, and his wife -- and the President hugged them both. The airplane carrying the evacuees, landed, and the President waited until the back of the plane opened, and the President walked up the ramp and went into the plane and visited with each of the wounded on the plane. He went alone--Mrs. Johnson stayed outside. After visiting w/ each, the President came down to the foot of the ramp and two people from Dallas--whose son was aboard the plane--greeted him. They were excited for they had learned only this morning that their son was arriving. Mrs. Johnson joined the President at the foot of the ramp and the boys started to come down. It was a very touching moment, and as each boy came down the emotions became higher. Ambulatory patients came first, and then the stretcher patients. The President greeted each. One patient was a little girl--who had been severely burned--(she was the daughter of a serviceman) -- and the President said hello to her and hoped she would be well soon.
