					The President said that this year to cut out all messages and use letters instead when possible.	
					Then Bill told the President that he had some things to tell him. He said that Forest Boyd asked him if there had been a NSC meeting with scientists involved last night. Chuck Bailey said that he knew the Vice President had been over with the President late last night, for he had called his office and one of his girls said he was tied up at the White House with the P ^r esident. Bill said he had low-keyed it and he thought it would not amount to anything.	
					Bill then said that Bill Lawrence wanted to interview the President and some of his staff for a color news program on January 9. The President said that he did not think his credibility good enough for Bill Lawrence, he would have to do with others instead. The President said the others can talk to anyone they want to, but they are here to work, not to appear on television. to answer questions. The President said if he were to do a show like this he would do it with Ray Scherer who is always honest and credible.	
					Then Bill told the President about Dan Rather coming in this afternoon with a request from Walter Cronkite to do a story on Marvin Watson. He had given a glowing report on MW, then about an hour later, Rather came in and said Cronkite had decided against it. Moral said Bill is they do not like to have good things only. The President then added many words of praise to MWs list.
