The President was introduced by Secy Fowler. The President thanked all the group for coming. He said "all of us look for opportunities to serve our country. Some men are dying for us today, to protect freedom and liberty. Others are serving in other ways. I am proud of the work, industrial progress, and industrial pledges of all of you. The record of the savings bond program has been phenomenal. It's a worthy and good cause. We want to take this opportunity to express our appreciation, and we look forward to good results in the days ahead." The President said he had been working to "get every drop of water out of the budget." This, he said, is making him unpopular with his Cabinet. "We want to maintain reasonable stability...there probably will be an increase of several billion in the Defense budget." "We need big men in the days ahead to give us leadership," the President concluded.
