MEMORANDUM FOR THE PRESIDENT'S APPOINTMENT BOOK

The President had as luncheon guests, February 3, members of the President's Foreign Intelligence Advisory Board. Clark Clifford, Board Chairman, reported on the Board's activities during the past year in general. He called on the following members of the Board for summaries of subjects in which they had particular interest:


Gordon Gray	Robert Murphy
Edwin Land	General Maxwell Taylor

The entire presentation and the discussion which followed concerned ways in which the Board is seeking to improve intelligence of all kinds which comes to the President and the President's senior subordinates.

The luncheon presentation was in broad generalizations but Mr. Clifford told the President that, as in the past, the Board would be sending specific recommendations to him following each monthly Board meeting.

Part of the discussion concerned the US/USSR Consular Treaty now before the Senate. The President engaged the interest of those present in their speaking to certain senators who now may be opposed to or are uncertain about the proposed treaty.

The President stated the major importance which he attached to the passage of the Consular treaty. He concluded the luncheon by thanking the Board members for their dedicated service to their government.
