					Memo fm Joe Califano says this Task Force has worked on the poverty program (and plans to adopt several of its tightening recommendations in our bill and Pres. 's Message). For past sev. weeks it has been working on the org. of domestic side of the Govt. This morning it was briefed by Gardner Ackley and the CEA on the org. of the Govt for economic planning. Heineman and his gp will get into the org of the foreign side of the Govt when it completes its current work. It has already done some preliminary staff work. Heineman met with Secy Katzenbach on this yesterday and would like to add Katzenbach to his Task Force but thinks that should be done from here through Rusk. (Joe Califano says he had dinner w/Heineman last night and Heineman said he had turned down a job as President of ConEd of New York because it would involve a 5-yr commitment and he wanted to be free to accept an attractive govt or university opportunity if one came along)
