					The President had asked that all the gifts given him, Mrs. Johnson and Lynda and Luci on South American trip - be brought to the LBJ Ranch office. Lynda had looked at a bracelet given her by President Joaquin Balaguer of Dominican Republic and taken it with her to the dining room table. She was showing it to her father and others there. mf got up from the table and went to get Luci Nugent's gift from President Balaguer -- a beautiful amber stone rosary accompanied by a letter from Pres. Balaguer. The President asked yb to translate it at the table which she did. At this point, Mr. Krim asked the President which President at the Summit Conference had impressed him most. The President said that he believed President Frei of Chili - although he also placed the President Costa da Silva of Brazil and the President of Paraguay on his list as most loyal friends too.

					Mr. Krim asked "what about the President of Mexico?" President replied	
					"well he too is a person of more than personal friendship but pretty much	
					left-wing.. more than I care for."	
					Conversation then got around to the Ecuadorian President who refused to sign	
					the President's Declaration at Summit Conf. The President said he too was	
					very left-wing that he thought Bobby Kennedy and Dick Goodwin really worked	
					on him. President said that John F. Kennedy's popularity had really	
					had a stronghold in that country. He said that Colombia, Chili, Mexico,	
					Venezuela all have more than better average men heading them.	
					He said 7 of the President simply denounced Ecuadorian President for	
					stand he took in not signing declaration ... that after he refused to sign	
					no-one applauded... and 7 of the President just took on after him for his position.	
					The President explained that the Alliance for Progress is a charter that was	
					written at Punta del Este in 1961.. but just a copy of the Act of Bogota in 1960.	
					Just a few words were changed---that Pres. John F. Kennedy had changed the	
					Act of Bogota to Alliance for Progress. He said that Dick Goodwin was a	
					wonderful writer, dramatic and colorful fellow who took the Act of Bogota	
					and decorated it.. which Secy Rusk took to Punta del Este and it was adopted as	
					the Alliance for Progress.	
					President said that during his three years since President he had increased	
					the Alliance for Progress to 5 billion as compared to 3 billion 7 during Kennedy's	
					administration.. but somehow as hard as he had tried to bring about the known	
					fact that the 35% increase under LBJ should be credited to him... all the Kennedyites	
					still credited JFK with all the glory and all the popularity that is associated	
					with the mere mention of "Alliance for Progress."	
					When asked how the Press had handled the Summit Conference in Latin America,	
					the President replied that he thought it had been good... fair.
