Wilbur Cohen The President told Mr. Cohen that he wanted him to do the impossible--that there are a thousand reasons why neither Johnson City nor Fredericksburg could get federal aid for a hospital, but he wanted Mr. Cohen to figure out how they both could. Presently there are two hospitals in Fredericksburg having a combined total of 38 beds--neither hospital is up to standards. Presently in Johnson City there is an 11 bed hospital. Mr. Cohen said he did not think he could swing a 50-bed hospital for Fredericksburg (as the people of Gillespie Co. are trying to raise money for a 50-bed hospital). Mr. Cohen said he could get a 30 or 35 bed hospital for Fredericksburg Fredericksburg and a 15 or 20 bed hospital for Johnson City--the President agreed. The President gave Mr. Cohen a xerox of the letter written to the President and Mrs. Johnson by Allen Keller, the Campaign Chairman of the Gillespie County Hospital Fund.
