The President talked during ax dinner a good bit w/ John Criswell about the President's Club dinner to be held here in October -- whether or not we could sell tickets, manner of handling entertainment, etc.	
	9:30p				The President to his bedroom - w/ Mr. and Mrs. McHugh, John Criswell, mf, Jim Jones the President got on his rubbing table and had a rub -- and read advance copies of TIME and NEWSWEEK -- Several times during the rub he dozed, only to wake up again and read the magazines -- or later in the evening, the Washington Post for Monday.
