NOMINATIONS SENT TO THE SENATE ON SEPTEMBER 18, 1967:

Alfred B. Fitt, of Michigan, to be an Assistant Secretary of Defense.

G. Joseph Minetti, of New York, to be a Member of the Civil Aeronautics Board for the term of six years expiring December 31, 1973. (Reappointment)

Juan B. Fernandez-Badillo, of Puerto Rico, to be United States District Judge for the District of Puerto Rico, vice Hiram R. Cancio.

Calvin K. Hamilton, of Missouri, to be United States Attorney for the Western District of Missouri for the term of four years, vice F. Russell Millin, resigned.

Yoshimi Hayashi, of Hawaii, to be United States Attorney for the District of Hawaii for the term of four years, vice Herman T. F. Lum, resigned.

Major General Winston P. Wilson, FG398325, Air National Guard, to be reappointed as Chief, National Guard Bureau, for a period of four years beginning September 1, 1967, under the provisions of Section 3015, Title 10 of the United States Code.
