					On Wednesday, October 4, 1967, at 1:00 p.m., Mr. Ernest Goldstein hosted a luncheon in the Fish Room attended by the following:	
					Ambassador Abdul-Hamid Sharaf, of Jordan; Ambassador Talat Al-Ghoussein, of Kuwait; Ambassador Ibrahim Hussein El-Ahdab, of Lebanon; Ambassador Ibrahim Al-Sowayel, of Saudi Arabia; Ambassador Rachid Driss, of Tunisia; Ambassador Fathi Abidia, of the Kingdom of Libya; Ambassador James Symington, Department of State; Mr. Lucius D. Battle, Assistant Secretary of State; Mr. Hal Saunders, National Security Council; Mr. Walt Rostow and Mr. Ernest Goldstein.	
					Early in the luncheon the President entered, accompanied by the Vice President, Secretary Rusk and Secretary McNamara. After all of those present were introduced to the President and his guests, the President, Secretary Rusk and Secretary McNamara departed. The Vice President remained and joined the group for lunch. At -- o'clock, when coffee was being served, the President returned and engaged in a full, frank and free discussion of current problems in the Middle East. After the President left, it was clearly apparent both by the remarks made at that time, and by subsequent statements from those participating, that the exchange of views had been most salutary.
