					President signed mail and worked pictures. On the table were letters of condolence to the relatives of Mrs. Helen Crouch Douglass who died October 8, 1966. The letters were not satisfactory. The Pres wanted them to say he had just learned of Mrs. Douglass death of last year. (He said it would be like Dorothy dying and his not knowing it. Wanted a check to be sure we had not done something last year -- couldn't understand how she could have died without his knowing -- without his being notified. "She was a sort of second mother to me." The President learned of Mrs. Douglass only yesterday when visiting with Dr. Perkins of Cornell University. In Williamsburg last week, the Pres, visiting with Dr. Perkins, talked of Mrs. Douglass and that he had lost touch with her. Asked Dr. Perkins to see if he could help get some word of her.)
