Fay, of Ireland; Ambassador Marquis de Merry del Val, of Spain; Ambassador Sir Patrick Dean, of the United Kingdom; Ambassador Ernst Lemberger, of Austria; Ambassador A. Edgar Ritchie, of Canada; Ambassador Arne Gunneng, of Norway; Ambassador Symington, Department of State; Mr. John Leddy, Assistant Secretary of State; Mr. Ed Fried, National Security Council; Mr. Walt Rostow and Mr. Ernest Goldstein. At coffee time the President, accompanied by the U.S. Ambassador to Malta and Mrs. George Feldman, joined the group and the Ambassadors and other guests were introduced to the President and to Ambassador and Mrs. Feldman. The President engaged in a frank discussion concerning current attempts to impose quotas on American imports. The President also discussed current policy in Viet-Nam.
