ARCHIVES PROCESSING NOTE

The President's Daily Diary pages for November 10 – 11, 1967, were missing when the Diary was transferred from the White House. On November 10 and 11, the President made a Veterans Day tour of Military Installations.

Other records at the LBJ Library show the President's schedule for the two days. On Friday, November 10, the President visited Fort Benning, Georgia; El Toro Marine Corps Air Station, Santa Ana, California; and Camp Pendleton, California. In the afternoon, the President boarded the aircraft carrier, the *U.S.S. Enterprise*, where he spent the night.

In the morning, Saturday, November 11 he spoke at Sunrise Ceremonies on the Flight Deck of the *U.S.S. Enterprise*. After departing the *Enterprise*, the President flew to McConnell Air Force Base, Kansas; then to Langley Air Force Base, Virginia; and on to Yorktown Coast Guard Station, Virginia. The President spent the night at Bassett Hall in Williamsburg, Virginia.
