The 16-year old son of President Sanchez of El Salvador -- Manuel Vicente Sanchez -- called on the President.

Young Sanchez is visiting the United States under the "Operation Amigo" exchange program. He was accompanied by Ambassador Clairmont-Duenas and "Operation Amigo" Director H. Stuart Morrison.

The President greeted the boy, presented him with an autographed plate of the 1967 Christmas stamp, had his picture taken with him, and asked him to carry back his best regards to his father with whom he had worked at Punta del Este.
