	1:35am				The President's plane, AF One 86970 landed at Loges AF Base, the Azores, Portugal. The President was in his bed asleep, but most of his staff and guests departed the aircraft to go to the local post exchange. The President awakened and decided to join at the PX.	
	2:10am				The President departed AF One 86970 by USAF car driven by Sgt. Lee, USAF w/ Clint Hill.	
	2:14	2:44am			The President at the Post Exchange, the Loges AF Base, the Azores, Portugal.	
					The President went through the PX, greeting staff and friends and examining their purchases. He then bought a small sterling silver cross for Lyn, then went to the baby department selecting clothes and toys for Lyn which he purchased. The President also bought several round brass trays made in French Morocco, and several silver bracelets. He greeted all the PX personnel as well as officers of the base who were gathered near the front door inside the PX. (The Exchange had agreed to open for the Presidential party, although it was the middle of the night.)	
					As the President started to leave the Exchange, he saw the Portuguese cooks and waiters gathered peering out the mess room window, and went down to greet them, but they fled, terrified, in all directions.	
					As the President went up to the waiting car, he stopped to greet the dependents of the US Base personnel -- they were obviously thrilled at the change to see and greet their President.
