Linder is Chairman of the Export-Import Bank lest This bill extends the life of the Export-Import Bank for five years - to June 1973. It increases the loan and guarantee and insurance authorization from \$9 billion to \$13.5 billion on the amount of loans, guarantees and insurance outstanding at any one time. It increases the bank's authority to issue export credit insurance and grown guarantees from \$2 billion to \$3, 5 billion. This bill also changed the name of the bank from Export-Import Bank of Washington to the Export-Import Bank of the United States of America.
