These maps illustrated Latin American physical integration possibilities. At the conclusion, Mr. Rostow said to the President, "Mr. President, the ratification of the Protocol of Amendments to the OAS Charter Charter is ready for your signature."

					He then introduced Hon. Edward Clark and presented to him his commission and as Executive Director of the Inter American Development Bank.
