					Today the President signed House Resolution 2434, a private relief bill for Nora Austin Hendrickson, of Greenville, South Carolina under the Veterans Benefits Provisions.	
					Today the President appointed Ralph E. McGill, of Atlanta Georgia as a member of the President's Commission for the Observance of Human Rights Year, 1968.	
					Today the President issued a proclamation of Prayer for Peace, Memorial Day, 1968	
					Today an additional 6 million dollars in Federal disaster funds was made available by the President for use in the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands battered by Typhoon Jean early in April.	
					Today the President issued a Proclamation naming May 13 Charlotte, North Carolina Day. This was the 200th anniversary of the establishment of the City of Charlotte.
