✓	9:25p				Preparations being made to transfer the casket from the train to the hearse, and President and Mrs. Johnson left the car, and were greeted by His Eminence Patrick Patrick Cardinal O'Boyle , Archbishop of Washington The Vice President and Mrs. Hubert Humphrey The Most Rev Terence J. Cooke, D. D., Archbishop of New York The group proceeded to the rear door of the hearse, where the President and Mrs. Johnson stood at the right side and the Vice President and Mrs. Humphrey at the left as the pallbearers placed the coffin inside. The President spoke briefly to Mrs. Robert Kennedy, to Senator Edward (Ted) Kennedy, and Robert Kennedy, Jr., before returning to his car.
