					Today the President signed H. R. 15856, the National Aeronautics and Space Administration Authorization Act for 1969 - total authorization is \$4,013,073,000, which is \$357 million below the President's budget request.	
					The President appointed Gov. Spiro T. Agnew of Maryland to be a member of the Advisory Commission on Inter-Governmental Relations, to succeed Gov. James Rhodes of Ohio who resigned. Gov. Agnew has been Governor of Maryland since 1966; he is an attorney and a Republican.	
					George Christian announced to Press that President intends to nominate Victor Frankil of Baltimore, Maryland, as a member of the Advisory Board for Post Office Department to succeed Fred Gates of Minneapolis.
