<p>Mildred Stegall sent a note to the President at 9:30a advising that Lyndon Jenkins was in town and that his one desire was to speak to the President. At 9:35a, Mrs. Johnson called Mildred and said, "Lyndon has given me your note, and, of course, we want to see him, and if you can get him over here at 11:15a, then I want to visit with him and show him around the second floor -- and then he can see the President." Gene Williams took Lyndon Jenkins over to the second floor at 11:15a, and he had a long visit with Mrs. Johnson. She showed him around the house, gave him a Coke, and took him in to see Zephyr. The President joined them at about 12:30 and sat down and talked to them a few minutes, asked him about his school, etc. The President also gave him a knife, a pen with the President's name on it, and a bookmark. Lyndon Jenkins left the mansion when the President came to his office, and he walked over with him.</p>
