Gene Williams took Lyndon Jenkins over to the second floor at 11:15a, and he had a long visit with Mrs. Johnson. She showed him around the house, gave him a Coke, and took him in to see Zephyr. The President joined them at about 12:30 and sat down and talked to them a few minutes, asked him about his school, etc. The President also gave him a knife, a pen with the President's name on it, and a bookmark. Lyndon Jenkins left the mansion when the President came to his office, and he walked over with him.
