January

1/13 **LBJ (Lyndon Johnson)** calls on President Roosevelt at White House.

1/19 White House congressional reception.

LBJ campaigns for Austin public housing project.

2/7 LBJ a guest at the White House for tea.

March

LBJ supports billion dollar Naval expansion bill.

April

LBJ supports presidential measure to enable the President to reorganize the Executive Branch. Bill defeated.

LBJ and other representatives ask the President to approve establishment of air mail service between Houston and Brownsville. Braniff vs. Eastern Airlines.

Spring LBJ has no opposition for re-election in primary.

June

CTJ (Lady Bird Johnson) and Rebekah Baines Johnson travel from Washington to Texas, visit Monticello and the Hermitage en route.

LBJ works for farm parity.

June or July

LBJ meets CTJ in Marshall, goes to coast for rest. LBJ secures approval of Cen-Tex Rural Electric Projects, largest allotment ever made by the Rural Electrification Administration.

LBJ works on report of Economic Condition of the South with Clark Foreman and Lowell Mellett(?).

Maury Maverick defeated in Democratic primary.

December

Austin – CTJ and LBJ drive past burning house, CTJ takes four children home until their parents return.

Trip to Europe sometime in 1938?
