Biographical sketch:

Leo M. Langlois (b. September 26, 1916-d. April 13, 2003, Conroe, Texas), executive with major advertising agencies such as Campbell-Ewald, Maxon Advertising, Cecil & Presbry and Clinton E. Frank. His studio affiliations include Metro Goldwyn Mayer, Archer Productions, Inc., and Columbia Pictures Television. He is best known for his production of "Duck and Cover" (1951), the first civil defense film made especially for children.

Scope and content note:

This collection pertains to a campaign song written for President Lyndon B. Johnson by Leo M. Langlois, titled "Johnson is Setting the Pace," and its performance for Johnson at a fundraising dinner for the Democratic Club of Cook County, Illinois, on April 23, 1964. The series consists of photographs and newspaper clippings.
