Edward Wenk was an engineer who served as senior specialist in science and technology for the Legislative Research Service, Technical Assistant to the President's Science Adviser, Executive Secretary of the Federal Council for Science and Technology, and Executive Secretary of the National Council on Marine Resources and Engineering Development.

Scope and content note:

This collection consists of correspondence, clippings, agendas, invitations, and meeting minutes maintained by Edward Wenk throughout his professional and personal life as a Naval engineer, a science and technology policy advisor for the U.S. Congress, a member of the National Council for Marine Resources and Engineering Development under Presidents John F. Kennedy, Lyndon B. Johnson, and Richard M. Nixon, and as a professor, lecturer, and author. Wenk's papers consist of publications and reports on engineering and marine science and education in science and technology. This collection also includes research material for Wenk's books and other published articles and reports.
